The Renata Elizabeth Withers Memorial Scholarship was initiated in 2008 by the Withers Family in memory of their daughter who lost her battle with anorexia nervosa in 2005. Since the scholarship was established 32 post-secondary students have benefited from the financial support that comes from winning the scholarship.
